Subject: Four Month Extension of YYZ Transportation Security and Restricted Area Identity Cards

To assist with the processing of new applicants and in support of airport operations, effective July 21, 2022, Transport Canada has extended all active and valid YYZ Transportation Security Clearances ("Clearances") and valid YYZ Restricted Area Identity Cards ("RAICs") with an expiry date between July 21, 2022, up to and including November 17, 2022, for an additional four (4) months from the date of expiry printed on the front of the RAIC.

This extension only applies to YYZ-issued permanent RAICs expiring between July 21, 2022, and November 17, 2022, inclusive. Employees do not need to attend the Pass Office to receive the extension. Airport access privileges will remain available during the extension period. In most cases, an individual's Clearance expiry date is the same as the expiry date printed on the front of their RAIC. As such:

- If the printed expiry date on the valid RAIC is July 20, 2022, the Clearance and RAIC expiry date will not change and remains July 20, 2022.
- If the printed expiry date on the valid RAIC is July 21, 2022, the new RAIC expiry date will now be extended by 4 months to November 21, 2022.
- If the printed expiry date on the valid RAIC is November 17, 2022, the new RAIC expiry date will now be extended by 4 months to March 17, 2023.
- If the printed expiry date on the valid RAIC is November 18, 2022, the clearance and RAIC expiry date will not change and remains November 18, 2022.

Exception: This extension **does not apply to Security Control Passes**. The process to extend Security Control Passes (yellow passes) remains the same. A Security Control Pass may be extended if it is valid by attending the Pass Office. If the Security Control pass expires, an authorized RAIC application is required to renew at the Pass Office.

To allow for the processing of new applicants, we recommend employees with permanent RAICs expiring within the above-mentioned timeframe seek to attend the Pass Office three (3) months before the extended expiration date to begin the renewal process.

Customers are required to book a spot in the Pass Office Virtual Queueing for all visits to the Pass Office at <https://www.torontopearson.com/ppco>. The Virtual Queue opens Monday to Friday from 0900H until 1500H with new spots opening every 30 minutes within that timeframe. The Virtual Queue is not available outside of these hours and on statutory holidays.
