A request was made by Councillor Knoll to have a NMT located in Halton	<p>The GTAA Airport Noise Operating Management System is currently equipped with 17 permanent noise monitoring terminals (NMTs) and two portable NMTs.</p> <p>The goal is to maintain an up-to-date noise monitoring and flight tracking system that provides an accurate history of measurable aircraft noise events. NMTs are tools to assist with the analysis and correlation of a noise complaint with an aircraft operation.</p> <p>A CENAC sub-committee was critical in the determination and review of the locations for these noise monitors. Below is a list of criteria that needed to be considered when selecting NMT locations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Proximity of NMT to flight paths · Proximity of NMT to Existing Noise Monitors · Proximity of NMT to Noise Sensitive Land Use · Background Noise Level · Utility Sources, Site Access and Security 	In Progress
